

Havis' Guide to Selecting a Prisoner Transport

Outfitting a van to handle prisoner transport is a great investment. Not only can you move up to 12 people at a time, but you can also use the van to patrol or to move big items like barricades, cones, bikes, or large evidence. It becomes part of your daily on-street fleet.

What exactly IS a Prisoner Transport Unit?

A prisoner transport unit is a specially designed metal insert that retrofits the back area of a van in order to carry prisoners from one location to another. It can also be used for storage and/or transport of large items. Some things to consider when purchasing a Prisoner Transport Unit are:

- **What Van Do I Need:** Havis Kwik-Kit® prisoner transport units are designed for installation in a standard cargo van. We recommend buying the heaviest gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) possible.
- **Versatile Compartments:** Havis offers compartment lengths ranging from 80" to 120", which can accommodate from 6 to 12 prisoners. Havis can offer you up to 4 compartments installed in a single van.
- **Materials & Finish:** Our units are fabricated primarily from 1/8" (.125") aluminum sheets that have a formed channel framework and are welded at critical joints. Plus, Havis uses a white powder coat finish to protect your unit and enable it to be thoroughly and easily cleaned.
- **Emergency Exits:** The Havis Kwik-Kit provides you with emergency exit hatches for every compartment that have quick-release slide bolts, gasket seal, perforated center section for viewing prisoners, clear Lexan polycarbonate cover over the perforated view section to protect officers, sealed edges to prevent the penetration of fluids, and minimized rattling for quieter driving.
- **Options & Accessories:** Havis offers different options for your unit to help officers and inmates. Our video system allows you to safely keep an eye on the prisoners in the back. Vent adapter kits connect to the OEM A/C for increased circulation. Flip down rear steps provide safe entry and exit for prisoners.
- **Transferable Units:** Havis units are not welded into your van; they are bolted. Even if you switch the manufacturer of your van (e.g. from Chevy to Ford), you can install your existing Havis Kwik-Kit unit.

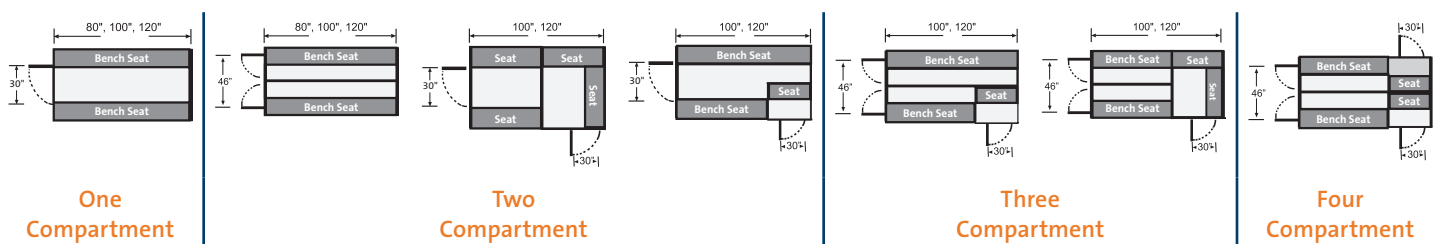
Basic Prisoner Transport Unit Choices

Havis Kwik-Kits are available for Ford and Chevrolet full size, standard and extended length vans, and Nissan NV and Sprinter Vans. They are available in different lengths of 80" (hold up to 8 passengers), 100" (hold up to 10 passengers) or 120" (hold up to 12 passenger), and in seven configurations for up to 4 compartments.
