

## **INSTALL INSTRUCTIONS C-VS-0812-INUT-1**

# 2013-2019 FORD INTERCEPTOR UTILITY with STANDARD INTERIOR Vehicle Specific Console

Note: This console can be used in an Interceptor Utility with Interior Upgrade (Code 65U).

However the optional CM007650 side trim panel kit must be ordered.

OEM inner dash bracket shown in step 8 is different (recessed further back)

The installer will also have to slightly modify the upper support bracket and supply two (2) ½" x 3 ½" bolts and two (2) 3" spacers for mounting upper bracket. (multiple hex nuts can be used to create spacers)

See last photo for reference CM007650 trim panels will also work with the standard Interceptor Utility without OEM console.



## C-VS-0812-INUT-1 Assembly









View of center console included with OEM Interior upgrade 65U.

## Optional side panels required for this console CM007650



Remove the TPMS module from the lower dash trim. (Module may not be present on 2016+ models)



Driver and Passenger floor mounting brackets

Remove OEM tunnel plate and lower dash trim included with Standard Interceptor Utility or center console included with Optional Interior upgrade.



Install TPMS module onto vent with supplied Velcro.



Bolt driver and passenger side front hump brackets to floor with previously removed OEM floor bolts.





Attach restraint control module to driver mounting bracket using 10-32 keps nuts.



Attach console upper front support bracket to backing plate studs with 10-32 nuts



Attach rear lower bracket to existing OEM mounting flanges with supplied 6mm x 20mm hex bolts and flat washers.

Place backing plate with studs behind the OEM upper center metal dash bracket with the studs facing towards rear of vehicle.

This OEM bracket is different for Interior Upgrade (Code 65U)

Re-install previously removed OEM trim panels.

Attach upper clip into the upper front support bracket as shown.



Slide console onto upper front support bracket from rear towards dash. The bracket <u>must</u> be above the side screws for proper alignment. Be careful not to scratch dash trim bezels





Loosely attach console top to support bracket with four (4)  $10-32 \times 3/4$ " machine screws.



Install the OEM aux panel or cover plate to side of console.

Wire and install equipment. Photo shows CF-31 with DS-PAN-111, C-MD-112, C-VS-0812-INUT-1, C-AP-0325, C-ARM-107, C-CUP2-I and C-USB-1.

Attach rear upper mounting bracket using and 1/4" x 3/4" bolts and washers. Install 1/4" x 3/4" carriage bolts through the side of the console and attach with 1/4" nuts.

### Tighten all hardware



OEM <u>optional</u> wire conduit shown.

Remove console end cutout and attach conduit to adaptor bracket with OEM bolts.

**Note:** Conduit may need to be temporarily removed in order to properly mount console housing.



Example of Interior Upgrade (Code 65U) inner dash bracket with two (2) ¼" x 3 ½" bolts and spacers for adapting to upper front support bracket CM007429. Bracket requires two small side trim mount tabs to be cut off. Spacer hardware and bracket modification to be provided by installer.
