

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

2. If converting another UT-2000 series product, first remove the existing side lugs and rear fences.
3. Loosely assemble the new kit to the base tray as shown in the exploded view.
4. Adjust and tighten the new kit according to the configuration instructions in the UT-2000 Series owner's manual or go to www.havis.com for more information.

NOTE: Retain all unused hardware for possible future re-use.

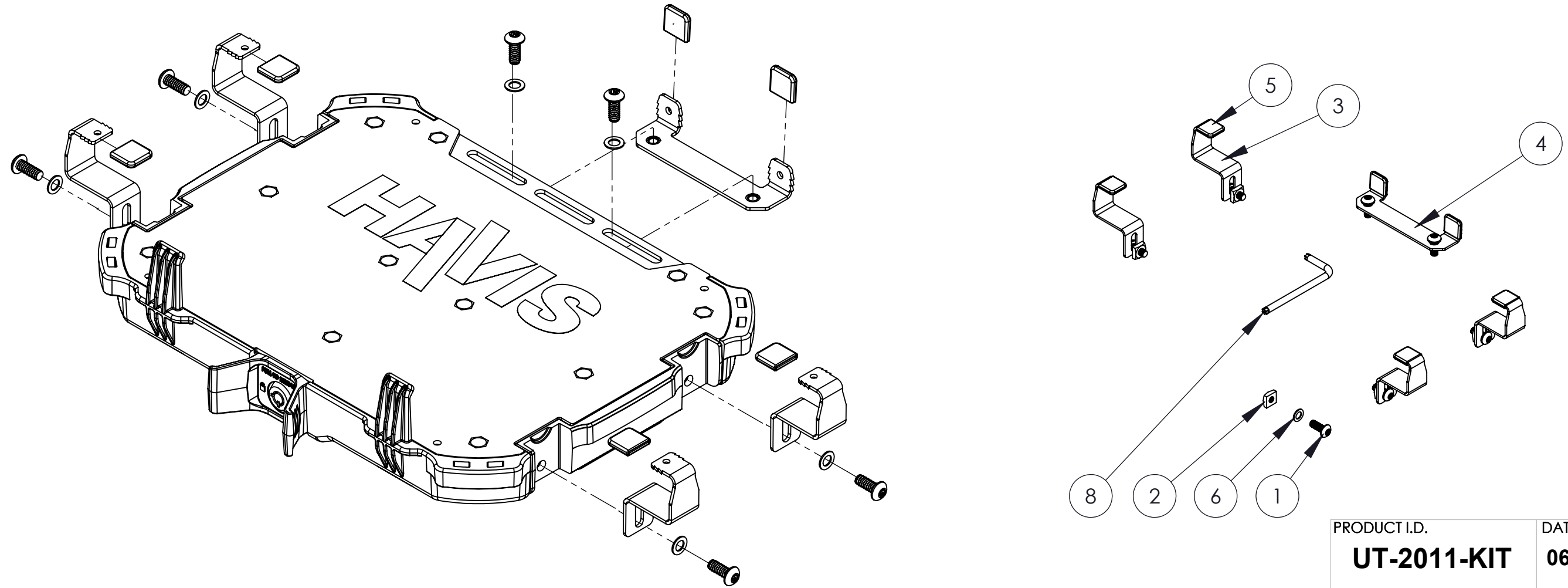
